

A 2.0 Safety Policy for Marine Operations

Issue: Two rev1

Being responsible for the safety of marine operations within the harbour area¹, Mostyn Docks Limited has established a safety policy for marine operations.

The safety policy for marine operations has been carefully formulated taking into account the standards set out in the Port Marine Safety Code and the need to safeguard the harbour, its users, the public and the environment. The safety policy is reproduced below:

Mostyn Docks Limited undertakes to provide and operate its services in accordance with a safety management system that has been developed based upon the findings of a formal risk assessment conducted to identify hazards arising from marine operations.

The objective of the safety management system is to ensure that the activities associated with marine operations are always conducted in a manner that minimises the risk of causing harm to people, property and the environment.

The safety management system has been developed to include measures that enable performance of the system to be measured and reviewed. This process provides management with the necessary information that indicates the level of compliance with its requirements. These include the discharge of its duties and powers, the safe and effective management of its assets including the maintenance of vessels and equipment to agreed industry standards and that staff are trained and competent for the task assigned.
